

# St Peter the Great County Parish Council

Minutes of a meeting of the Parish Council held on **Monday 25<sup>th</sup> June 2007** at **7.45pm in the Village Hall, St Peters.**

**4507 Declarations of Interest:** There were no declarations of interests.

**4607 Co-option of Councillors:** There were no nominations to consider.

**4707 Adoption of Minutes:** The Minutes of the Annual Meeting of the Parish Council held on 14<sup>th</sup> May 2007 were adopted and signed.

**4807 Short Information Reports:**

- (a) Members received a written report from the local Warden in respect of environmental issues and details of maintenance carried out at St Peter's.
- (b) Pc. Chuter and Sgt Murphy advised Council on current issues and dealt with a perceived communication problem and complaint procedure, in particular, contractors site vehicles causing problems for residents at the Old Oil Depot development. Other issues such as on street car selling and isolated local youth difficulties were noted by P.C. Chuter for early attention. The Chairman thanked them for their good work at St Peter's.

**4907 Brief Adjournment:**

A brief adjournment to enable members of the public to participate included an up-date from the Duckworth Trust Warden Mr. D. Edgerton regarding several local environmental matters. The Rev. D. Ballard reported on recent vandalism at St Mark's Church and a new youth project successfully dealing with this problem, made possible by a £7k grant aided scheme. The Chairman thanked them for their valuable input.

- (a) There was no new proposal in respect of the provision of partnership funding to enable the County Council to provide safe crossing on St Peter's Drive.

## **5307 Code of Conduct & Training:**

**Council unanimously resolved to adopt the new model Code of Conduct** with immediate effect, but to exclude any compulsory requirement for Councillors to attend training sessions on specific dates and times, thereby retaining the Councillor's individual right to opt for training as and when possible and/or convenient.

Council continued to approve the current arrangement, whereby available training is notified to Councillors, and training for new Councillors arranged by the Clerk as necessary.
