The City Council Parks Section is busy switching between our busy winter programme and our summer programme, grass cutting activity has increased to fortnightly across the parish and the fair weather has helped to ensure we achieve a good cut, as ever if you notice some grass that's not been cut or have any issues about quality please let us on 01905 722233 or via the parish clerk.

The parish warden team have been sorting out many of the minor quality issues across the estate, full details are circulated at the monthly parish meeting. If you have any ideas on small projects to improve the parish then you can contact the team via the parish clerk.
